



## Coming this fall: TRAINING OPPORTUNITY



In conjunction with the De Pere FD, the Wisconsin Society of Emergency Service Instructors (WSESI) will provide **NFPA 1403 Live Fire Training** in early fall. The training will consist of doing live burns with acquired structures in the De Pere, Wisconsin area. One home will be burned in the fall of 2024 and the other in the spring of 2025. This will be a three-day event starting on a Friday.

**Day 1:** In the classroom portion, we will discuss permitting, asbestos removal, lesson plans/objectives, a 1403 overview, and water supply. DNR and Asbestos Removal Company will be special guest speakers.

**Day 2:** We will be at the acquired structure to prep it, build the sets, talk about rotations, wayward students, etc.

The WSESI wants to focus on the prep work leading up to the burn day, as the burn is easy.

**Day 3:** Will consist of room burns with live fire, all following NFPA 1403 regulations.

Some pre-classroom work must also be completed before the first training day. This is an opportunity for instructors to work through the whole process, from acquiring a structure to burning and finishing the day with a safe training event.
